Audacious : all 3.x versions (even git, tested two days ago).			
When audacious start, the main window is not placed where it was closed. This issue happens only if audacious main window is placed lower enough in the screen and happens only for vertical position. Horizontaly it is always well placed.			
Playlist and equalizer windows are well placed.

I will re-post some day as this happens also in KDE 4.8.5. In fact with KDE the main window can not be dragged in the lower 60% of the screen, it blocked for moving in the upper part of the screen. The playlist has not the problem.
