Description

On some mp3's (maybe also other formats) I get wrong track lengths displayed. It appears this happens with specific types of mp3 files, since when it happens, it happens for the whole Album.

For reproducibility I have uploaded an mp3 file which is actually 3:15 min long but Audacious shows 3:30 min.

This happens independent of the OS.
