Good day!			
I'm using Ubuntu Linux 11.10 and Audacious 3.2.2 with the Global Hotkey module enabled, which I'm trying to use with my A4Tech KBS-26 multimedia keyboard.			
Each time I reboot the system the multimedia keys stop working for Audacious (only, Banshee and Rhythmbox seem to be fine). To make the keys work I have to go Preferences-Modules-General-Global Hotkey and open the preferences of the module, then quit it without changing anything. This makes the keys work (sometimes only some of them work after the first time, so I have to repeat to make others work also). This works while the session is running, but after a restart I have to repeat the steps to make everything work again.
