<b>Description</b>			
It's nice to be able to right click on a track currently playing and select delete in order to remove it permanently. A confirmation dialog is no problem.			
This is a lot less hassle than having to open the folder, find the track, then delete it, then confirm a confirmation dialog.			
This feature would allow for cleaning up of music databases much more quickly, and should be trivial to implement.
