<b>Description</b> <p>I have a portable DAC (HiBy FC3) that is very aggressive regarding energy saving so that when it detects no streaming it turns off. I noticed that on Audacious if I start playing a 44 KHz file and change to a 48 KHz file (and vice-versa), something happens that my DAC turns off. Since this DAC has a fade in when it turns on, this issue can be pretty annoying when listening to a playlist with different sample rate tracks.</p> <p>This issue also happens on DeaDBeeF and Mpv (both Linux and Windows), however it doesn't happen on Winamp or MPC-HC (either via Wine or Windows native), so I guess there's a way to fix this.</p> <p>I'm currently running Slackware x64 current.</p>
