<b>Description</b>			
<p>I have a few songs that I've tagged with id3tool and id3v2 and audacious can't read it's tags.</p> <p>This is not commonly reproducible since all of my tracks are either tagged by id3tool/id3v2 or at least can be read by them.</p> <p>The only fix seems to be to write the tags with audacious, or at least save the empty tags with audacious which clears the mp3 tags, then I can write them with id3tool and see them in audacious - but only after re-adding the song to the playlist.</p> <p>An example song showing the failure is at:</p> <p><a href="http://GetDave.com/tmp/audacious_tags.mp3">http://GetDave.com/tmp/audacious_tags.mp3</a></p>
