Description When loading a cue sheet for a flac file, the cue sheet had the "file" attribute misnamed with a .wav extension instead of .flac, so when adding it to the playlist I get a no such file or directory error, but the tracks still come up on the playlist. When actually trying to play from the playlist, audacious starts taking up 100% cpu and stops responding.
