#### Description

When the import/export dialog for playlists is closed by clicking "Cancel", this warning is printed:

```
** (audacious:23202): CRITICAL **: set_str: assertion 'name && value' failed
```

This happens only if the playlist was not exported before and hence "`~/config/audacious/playlist-state`" does not contain "filename".
