Audacity ignores directory symlinks on purpose (changed here <https://redmine.audacious-media-player.org/issues/892>), which makes it impossible to add multiple folders to the library and generally makes it difficult to work with symlinked shortcuts.

It would be great, if there was an option to enable this behavior for users, who are aware of the consequences (potential infinite recursion). The option could be in Settings > Advanced > Playlist > Follow Folder Symlinks.

I wouldn't mind taking a stab at it myself and doing a pull request, but the build instructions are very outdated.
