Description <p>With the 3.10.1 GTK version of Audacious (on Ubuntu 20.04, for example), with the Winamp Classic Interface, I can detach the equalizer and easily place it in the corner of my display. When the equalizer gets near the corner, it just snaps into place.</p> <p>With the 4.0.2 Qt version of Audacious (on Void Linux, for example), with the Winamp Classic Interface, I can also detach the equalizer. However, when I try to place the equalizer in the corner of my display, it does not snap into place.</p> <p>I prefer to be able to quickly snap pieces of the Winamp interface into the corners of my display.</p> <p>I can provide screenshots if that would be helpful.</p>
